The State of Wisconsin, to any Sheriff, or any Law Enforcement officer of the State of Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, 1. oral testimony was presented to Reserve Judge Neal Nettesheim sitting in the First Judicial District and recorded by a stenographic reporter on November 1, 2010, and

WHEREAS, 2. has complained (by attached affidavit) to this court upon oath,

Showing probable cause that on today's date in the County of Columbia, there is now located and concealed in and upon certain premises, located within the City of Columbus in said County, and more particularly described as follows:

DESCRIBE PREMISES:

Premises occupied by Kelly Rindfleisch, having a street address of 331 West Harrison Street, Columbus, Wisconsin and more particularly described as a two story single family home having yellow siding, white trim, and a gray shingle roof. The numbers "331" are clearly affixed above the door facing West Harrison Street. See Exhibit A. This search shall include the blue on blue Mercury Mariner sport utility vehicle bearing plate 280GCT with VIN 4M2CU97168KJ08931 registered to Kelly Rindfleisch. Further this search shall include all storage areas accessible to 331 West Harrison Street and all persons present on premises, certain good, chattels and property, to-wit:

DESCRIBE OBJECTS OF SEARCH:

All records and information relating to violations of sections 946.12, 11.36 and 11.61 of the Wisconsin Statutes, viz., Misconduct in Public Office and Political Solicitation involving Public Officials and Employees for the time period since January 1, 2009 relating directly or indirectly to political activity while a County employee.

As used in this warrant, the terms "records" and "information" to include all items of evidence in whatever form and by whatever means they may have been created or stored, including any form of computer or electronic storage (such as hard disks, jump drives, thumb drives, CDs, DVDs, external USB drives, 3.5" disks or other media that can store data); any handmade form (such as writing, drawing, painting); any mechanical form (such as printing or typing); and any photographic form (such as microfilm, microfiche, prints, slides, negatives, videotapes, motion pictures, photocopies).

This warrant extends to, and authorizes the seizure of, all laptop and desktop computers.

Financial records, including bank records and statements on the premises for Kelly Rindfleisch and/or JVS Consulting.

Cell phone records and records relating to remote data storage.

The term "political activity" means campaign activities, the making or soliciting of campaign contributions, fundraising, and/or lobby activities.

THIS WARRANT AUTHORIZES A FORENSIC EXAMINATION OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT AND PERIPHERAL DEVICES SEIZED DURING EXECUTION.

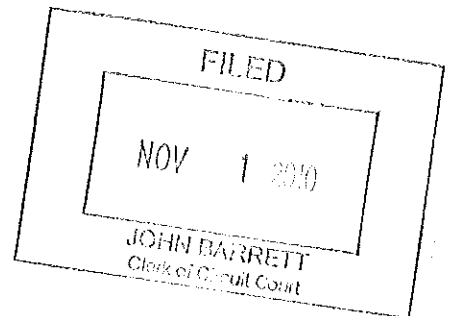
Which objects constitute evidence of the commission of a crime, to wit;

DESCRIBE CRIME OR CRIMES:

- (1) Misconduct in Public Office; and
- (2) Political Solicitation involving Public Officials and Employees
