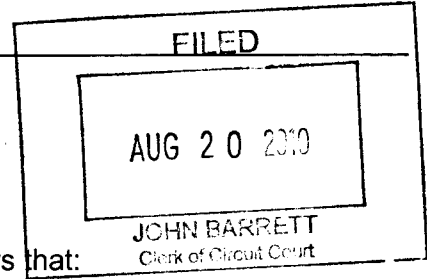


**AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF ENLARGEMENT OF THE SCOPE OF THE JOHN DOE PROCEEDINGS AND APPLICATION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF JOHN DOE SUBPOENAS**

David E. Budde, being first duly sworn on oath, deposes and says that:

1. I am the Chief Investigator of the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office. I am a sworn law enforcement officer as described in previous Affidavits submitted in this John Doe investigation. I am assigned as the District Attorney Investigator acting in support of the above-captioned John Doe proceedings.

2. This Application is made to request subpoenas for certain employees of the Information Management Services Division (IMSD) of Milwaukee County. Based upon information I have received, I understand that the persons named below are all employed by the Milwaukee County Information Management Services Division and are the persons best qualified to supply the court with information concerning this investigation.

3. I incorporate by reference all the Applications and Affidavits heretofore submitted to the court in this investigation.

4. Generally speaking, this current request for Subpoenas Duces Tecum is occasioned by the return of a Search Warrant served upon Google Gmail for timrussellwi@gmail.com. This information, received late yesterday afternoon, was reviewed for the first time today. I respectfully submit to the court that I have reviewed the attached Exhibits A to 5, taken from Mr. Russell's Gmail account. All of these communications were made at times when Mr. Russell's Ceridian time records indicate Mr. Russell was working as a Milwaukee County employee. Further, I am informed by Mary Ann Grimes, an attorney working with the Office of the Corporation Counsel on behalf of the Department of Administration, that County records show that Tim Russell served as the Deputy Chief of Staff to the County Executive from January 26, 2009, through March 14, 2010. Subsequently, I know that Mr. Russell was assigned as an Administrator in the Department of Health and Human Services. While we are at present preparing papers for a Search Warrant to seize Mr. Russell's county computers, I submit that the attached Exhibits form a basis for Assistant District Attorney Bruce J. Landgraf's Petition for the Enlargement of the Scope of the John Doe Proceedings.

5. The court has previously recognized the value of phone records to this investigation. Such phone records will be potential evidence of conversations of a political and/or campaign nature occurring during the work day of Milwaukee County employees. I am advised that phone records for Milwaukee County phones are available for a twenty-four month period. I submit that phone records attributable to Darlene Wink (414-278-4191) and Tim Russell (414-278-4216 and 414-289-5949) will be valuable information to this investigation.

6. Therefore, in connection with this John Doe investigation, I respectfully request that the court issue the following process for the following reasons:

a. **Laurie Panella / Subpoena Duces Tecum.** For those same reasons identified in connection with the request to preserve Milwaukee County digital data for Darlene Wink, I request that the court issue a Subpoena Duces Tecum for the user data relating to Tim Russell in the custody and control of IMSD and Laurie Panella.

b. **Ed White / Subpoena Duces Tecum.** I request that the court issue a Subpoena Duces Tecum for Mr. Ed White, a person identified to me by Laurie Panella as essential for the provision of the computer data now in the possession of IMSD relating to Tim Russell.

c. **Tyrone Johnson / Subpoena Duces Tecum.** I request that the court issue a Subpoena Duces Tecum for Mr. Tyrone Johnson, a person identified to me by Laurie Panella as essential for the provision of the computer data now in the possession of IMSD relating to Tim Russell.

d. **Angela Bussing / Subpoena Duces Tecum.** I request that the court issue a Subpoena Duces Tecum for Ms. Angela Bussing, a person identified to me by Laurie Panella as essential for the provision of the computer and digital equipment records (as specified in the subpoena) now in the possession of IMSD.

e. **Deborah Stanford / Subpoena Duces Tecum.** I request that the court issue a Subpoena Duces Tecum for Ms. Deborah Stanford, a person identified to me by


Laurie Panella as essential for the provision of the phone records now in the possession of IMSD relating to Darlene Wink and Tim Russell.

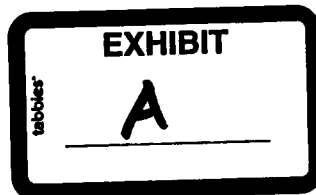

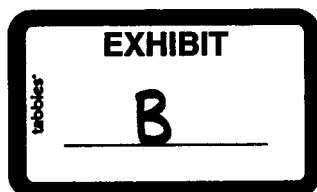

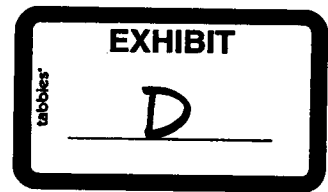

## **Parkway delay angers officials Cudahy, St. Francis mayors say GOP move threatens development**

Political and business leaders in Cudahy and St. Francis

were angered Monday by Assembly GOP budget recommendations that included a one-year delay in completing the long-awaited Lake Parkway.

Characterizing the parkway as a key to economic development, they said some area businesses already had made important decisions as a result of promises made by Gov. Tommy Thompson and other state officials. "I don't think it speaks well for the present administration or the Republican leadership of the Legislature," Cudahy Mayor Raymond Glowacki said. "I believe the moneys are there. This Lake Parkway isn't something that has come out of the blue sky in the last couple of years.

"I really felt that the coming of the parkway could be an absolute renaissance for the southeastern part of the county. We have had businesses that have expanded on the promise of the Lake Parkway. For us to take a hit such as this, I really believe this is not good for Milwaukee, St. Francis or Cudahy."

The parkway would link downtown Milwaukee with the southeastern suburbs by carrying traffic from the southern end of the Hoan Bridge to E. Layton Ave. Plans to widen Pennsylvania Ave. south of Layton also would be delayed as part of a budget proposal worked out last week by members of the Republican caucus, according to Rep. Scott **Walker** (R-Wauwatosa). Details of the plan were released Monday.

**Walker** said caucus members were aware of the economic impact of their decision on the two communities but had to weigh other considerations. A major decision was that they had few options for saving money and could not delay major road work on the Interstate 94 east-west corridor more than one year. Any longer delay in that project would have forced the state to put weight restrictions on trucks

using the **Zoo Interchange**, he said.

The Lake Parkway was among the projects selected for a delay primarily because it was not on the Department of Transportation's long-term transportation and safety list, **Walker** said. The east-west corridor involved safety concerns as well as significant economic ramifications, he noted.

Work on the 3.5-mile parkway has been under way for some time. Contracts for two other major parts of the project the parkway interchanges at Howard Ave. and Carferry Drive will be awarded this week using money in the current budget,

transportation officials said. When those are awarded, nearly half of the project's estimated \$110 million cost will have been spent.

Existing plans call for the parkway to be completed by late 1998. So far, the project is on schedule, according to Tom Longtin, the Transportation Department's project manager, and his supervisor, Ron Felsner.

Because of inflation, each year the project is delayed will add about 3% to the remaining costs, Felsner and Longtin said.

A year's delay also would jeopardize a one-year agreement, effective July 1, between local railroads over shared use of track leading to the Port of Milwaukee. It took five years for the state to get the competing railroads to agree to share track while portions of track are torn up and rerouted for the parkway. The railroads use track for access to the port and for assembling freight trains.

An Area Cut Off

David Stawski, president of the St. Francis Association of Commerce, said the parkway would help provide better access to the southeastern part of the county, which has suffered because of a lack of major north-south and east-west links with Milwaukee and the freeway. He found any delay troubling.

"This project is critical to us," Stawski said. "In my opinion, this project was signed, sealed and delivered, and now has become something of a political football.

**Transit projects a good use of funds**

Nick Rudelich's June 11 letter to The Morning Mail shows that he has a short and limited memory when it comes to transportation funding. Originally, \$241 million of federal funds was set aside for use on the East-West Corridor. Specifically, the money could be used for a light rail system along the corridor or for the widening of I-94 to insert car pool and bus lanes.

During debate over a locally preferred alternative last May, leaders in Milwaukee County pushed a plan including a multimillion-dollar light rail system, while leaders in Waukesha County pushed for freeway lanes that would have eaten into residential and commercial property in Milwaukee County.

At that time, a group of Milwaukee County lawmakers objected to both proposals.

Fast forward to May 1998. The same Milwaukee County lawmakers -- three Democrats and three Republicans -- applauded the change in the use of the \$241 million and asked that the funds be used on local projects, including the reconstruction of the Marquette Interchange, the **Zoo Interchange** and on expanding support for the Milwaukee County Transit System.

In our opinion, supporting these projects is a better use of the funds and will ultimately save Milwaukee County taxpayers money.

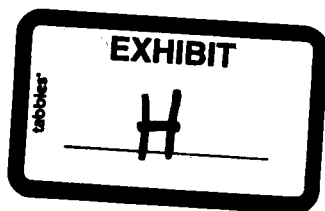
